

PAD London welcomes 13 firsttime exhibitors

Among the London events coinciding with Frieze Masters is PAD London, the annual design fair that takes place in Berkeley Square.



It features pieces such as this drop-leaf desk with its seat and visitor's stool by French designer and architect Jacques Adnet (1900-84). It features an X-shaped base in bamboo-imitation brass. The covering and top of the tray are covered with imitation leather. The set is available from newcomer **Unforget**, a Belgian gallery, for £40,000.

This year marks the 15th anniversary of the fair. It brings together 62 international galleries, with 13 first-time exhibitors. Fresh faces include **JCRD Design, Giulia de Jonckhere** and **Elie Top**.

Many of the offerings are Contemporary, but of the standout 20th century pieces are a desk by André Sornay that transforms into a games table, offered by **Marcelpoil**, and a bar cabinet attributed to Otto Shulz on the stand of **Modernity**.
