again reigns over Berkeley Square when 62 dealers set up shop for the eighth edition, running October 15 through 19. Among the newcomers are Daniel Blau of Munich and London, who is presenting newly discovered drawings from the mid 1950s by Andy Warhol, and Robilant & Voena of Milan and London, which is bringing a late, marine blue canvas by Lucio Fontana, Concetto Spaziale Attese, 1968. Parisian imports Alain de Monbrison and Galerie Flak will offer rare African and Oceanic pieces. For the first time, 20th-century Brazilian design will be in evidence with Paris-based Galerie James, which is exhibiting a pair of 1962 armchairs by Joaquim Tenreiro and a 1959 tea cart by Jorge Zalszupin.
