Ten Must-See 2014 PAD London Booths

PAD London

One of the standout events of London's heavily saturated October "Frieze Week" celebration of art is PAD London, the city's leading fair for 20th Century art, design and decorative arts. Now in its eighth year, PAD London is an eclectic showcase of covetable objects spanning modern art, photography, design, as well as decorative and tribal arts.

The 2014 edition of PAD London, which returns to Berkeley Square from October 15-19, brings together 62 prominent galleries from Europe, North America, and the Middle East.

Highlights of the event include the presentation of underrecognized Brazilian design by Paris-based James Gallery, London-based Finch & Co's cabinet of curiosities, the solo exhibition of rediscovered drawings by Andy Warhol at Daniel Blau of Munich and London, and London-based Elisabetta Cipriani's showcase of jewellery by contemporary artists.

To help visitors navigate the fair, BLOUIN ARTINFO has selected ten must-see booths.

Sèvres - Cité de la céramique

Renowned French porcelain factory Sèvres – Cité de la céramique will present commissioned works of ceramic art by the likes of Aldo Bakker, Pierre Charpin, Lionel Estève, Gustavo Lins, Pucci de Rossi, Grégoire Scalabre, and Ettore Sottsass. The centerpiece of the booth will be a life size ceramic dress by Brazilian fashion designer Gustavo Lins.

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Carpenters Workshop Gallery

Carpenters Workshop Gallery of Paris and London is renowned for its discovery of bold and iconic design-art. This year the Gallery will present a group show featuring works by Atelier Van Lieshout, Wendell Castle, Ingrid Donat, Vincent Dubourg, Rick Owens, Random International, and Yinka Shonibare MBE.

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James Gallery

Paris-based James Gallery specializes in the underrecognized movement of 20th century Brazilian modernism. The James Gallery booth will featured works by Brazilian designers Joaquim Tenreiro, Jorge Zalszupin and José Zanine Caldas alongside pieces by emerging Brazilian designer Zaninide Zanine.

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Elisabetta Cipriani - Jewellery by **Contemporary Artists**

London-based Elisabetta Cipriani – Jewellery by Contemporary Artists collaborates with renowned international sculptors and painters to create wearable sculptures using precious metals and stones. At PAD London Cipriani will exhibit works by a range of artists including Erwin Wurm, Avish Khebrehzadeh, Alexander Calder, and Alighiero Boetti.

Exhibiting for the first time at PAD, London-based Finch & Co aim to create the greatest of 21st Century cabinets of curiosities at the fairs they participate in. Expect to find an eclectic range of items from fossil remains of an Ichthyosaurus to Ottoman sherbet spoons.

Daniel Blau of Munich and London will present a solo exhibit of rediscovered drawings by Andy Warhol including a number of Warhol's famous "Daphnis and Chloe" preparatory drawings.
