PAD LONDON ANNOUNCES 2018 LINE-UP

1-7 October 2018, Berkeley Square, Mayfair

PAD LONDON, the internationally acclaimed fair for art and design, returns for its 12th edition next month. Set in the vibrant heart of Mayfair, PAD London is the capital's leading fair for design, decorative arts and 20th century art.

This year's London edition introduces a magnificent showcase of works staged by 68 leading galleries. Ten new international galleries will make their debut at PAD London this year.

HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE

- Italian designer Achille Salvagni presents an elegant display inspired by Marie-Laure de Noailles' signature eclecticism, mixing cultures and genres.
- Archaeologist Veta Stefanidou Tsoukala brings a refined selection of art and design wonders evocative of the classical forms of Greek antiquity.
- Parisian ceramicist Karen Swami features her poetic minimal vases inspired by traditional Japanese stoneware.

Collectible jewellery has gained huge momentum at international art fairs, a genre supported by PAD since its inception in 2007. For this edition PAD London will broaden its offering with new specialist galleries.

- French designer Lorenz Bäumer, former Artistic Director for high jewellery at Louis Vuitton and creator of emblematic collections for Chanel, exhibits whimsical architectural pieces that marry

his education as an engineer and his passion for poetry, nature and colour.

- Lebanese designer Walid Akkad offers minimal yet opulent jewels reflecting his quest for timeless beauty and impeccable craftsmanship.
- Glenn Spiro, master British jeweller and former Christie's expert, unveils his spectacular designs inspired by nature.

Contemporary design galleries choose PAD London again to unveil brand new works by emerging and established designers.

- Carpenters Workshop Gallery devises an immersive solo exhibition with new works by sculptural furniture designer Ingrid Donat.
- Gosserez brings an exciting array of up-and-coming designers pushing the boundaries of materials.
- Peter Petrou introduces an enticing cabinet of curiosities with new works by Irish designer Sasha Sykes.

The PAD London Prize returns with a prestigious panel of judges co-presided over by Yana Peel and Francis Sultana.

Three awards will be presented in the following categories: Best Contemporary Design, Best 20th Century Design and Best Stand. ■
