PAD LONDON ADDS PRESTIGIOUS NEW GALLERIES TO ITS 2017 LINE-UP

29 June 2017 — PAD LONDON, the internationally acclaimed fair for art and design, returns to Berkeley Square for its eleventh edition running from 2-8 October 2017. This year's fair brings together sixty-seven leading galleries showcasing masterpieces across disciplines and periods encompassing contemporary, modern and historical design, jewellery, tribal art and antiquities. Eleven first-time exhibitors will further enrich the depth and scope of PAD's exceptionally diverse offering: **Anne Autegarden** from Belgium; **Avant-Scène**, **Alexandre Biaggi**, **Nicolas Bourriaud**, **Marcilhac**, **Ma Tei**, **Meubles et Lumières** and **Mouvements Modernes** from France; **DIMOREGALLERY** and **Rossana Orlandi** from Italy; and **Portuondo** from the UK and Spain.

Contemporary design at PAD shines this year with the arrival of two prominent Milanese galleries championing a new wave of eclecticism: **DIMOREGALLERY**, mixing the sensual and colourful creations of celebrated design duo Brit Moran and Emiliano Salci with carefully selected vintage and contemporary pieces, and **Orlandi** with her inimitable blend of inspiring findings and quirky furniture by international design talents. In Paris, **Mouvements Modernes**, a gallery historically reputed for commissioning new work by living designers, presents a panorama of iconic works by Matthew Chambers, Elizabeth Garouste and Martin Szekely. Another Parisian heavyweight, **Avant-Scène**, celebrates 31 years at the forefront of collectible design and introduces special commissions by Hubert Le Gall, Franck Evennou, Elizabeth Garouste and Mark Brazier-Jones at PAD London.

This edition reveals museum-quality works from experts in 20th century design. **Biaggi** (Paris) brings outstanding works by French designer Marc du Plantier, British-born American designer and tastemaker T. H. Robsjohn-Gibbins, and an exceptional sculptural lamp produced by Alberto Giacometti in collaboration with French interior

designer Jean-Michel Frank. **Autegarden** (Brussels) exhibits rare pieces from mid-century Italian designers such as Gio Ponti and Carlo de Carli. **Marcilhac**, the oldest Parisian gallery devoted to 20th century decorative arts, presents an exquisite piece by prominent French interior designer Armand-Albert Rateau (1882-1938), alongside armchairs by French Art Deco master Eugène Printz (1889-1948). Rounding up the selection of first-time exhibitors in this category, **Meubles et Lumières** (Paris) displays mid-century floor lamps by notable French post-war designers Robert Mathieu and Pierre Guariche.

This year, the PAD London Restaurant and Ruinart Champagne Bar will be adorned with luxury fabrics, furniture and wallpapers by French house **Pierre Frey**. Founded in 1935, the family-owned design house is dedicated to preserving traditional French techniques while drawing inspiration from four corners of the world.

The **PAD London Prize** returns with a prestigious panel of judges presided over by Jasper Conran. Three awards will be presented in the following categories: Best Contemporary Design, Best 20th Century Design and Best Stand.
