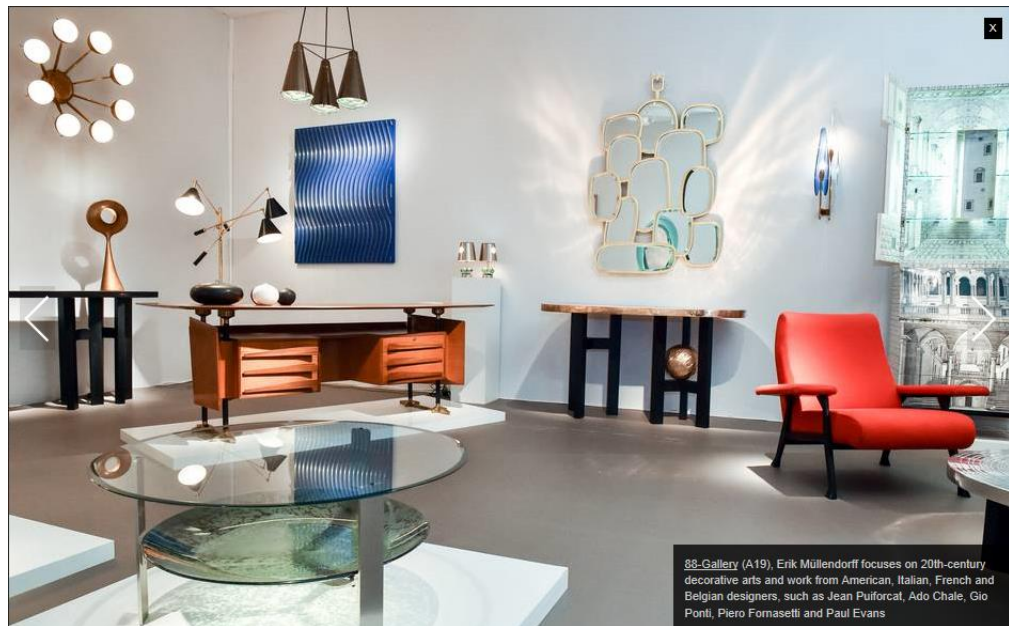




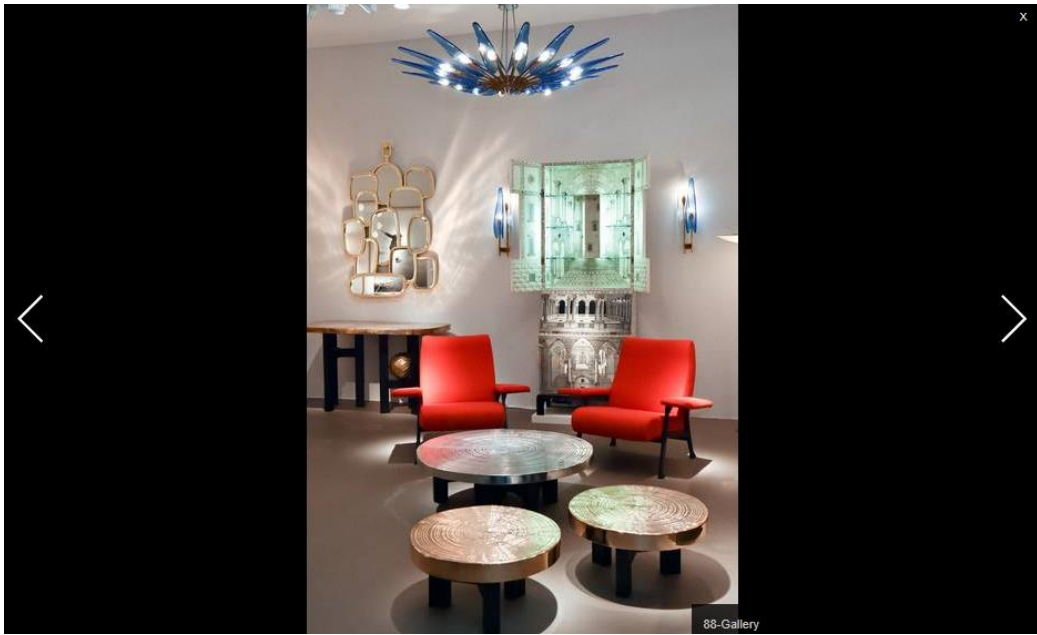
Negropontes (B15) featuring the Diversion and Regard mirrors, Op Art Chest and Gio Coffee Table by Hervé Langlais, 2015



Chahan (A23), Chahan Minassian is an interior designer, antique dealer and gallerist



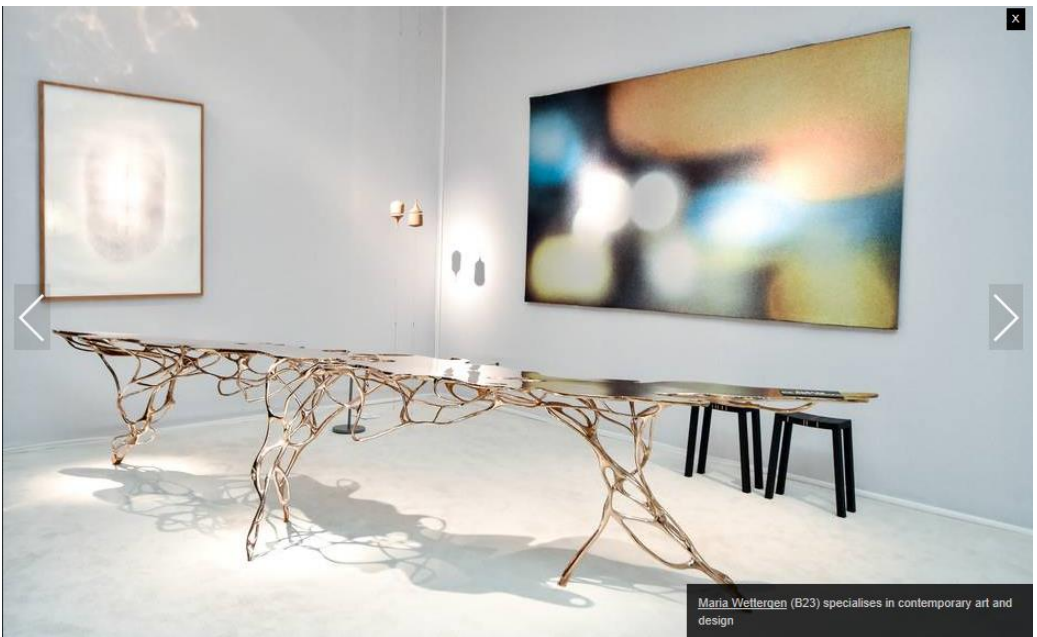

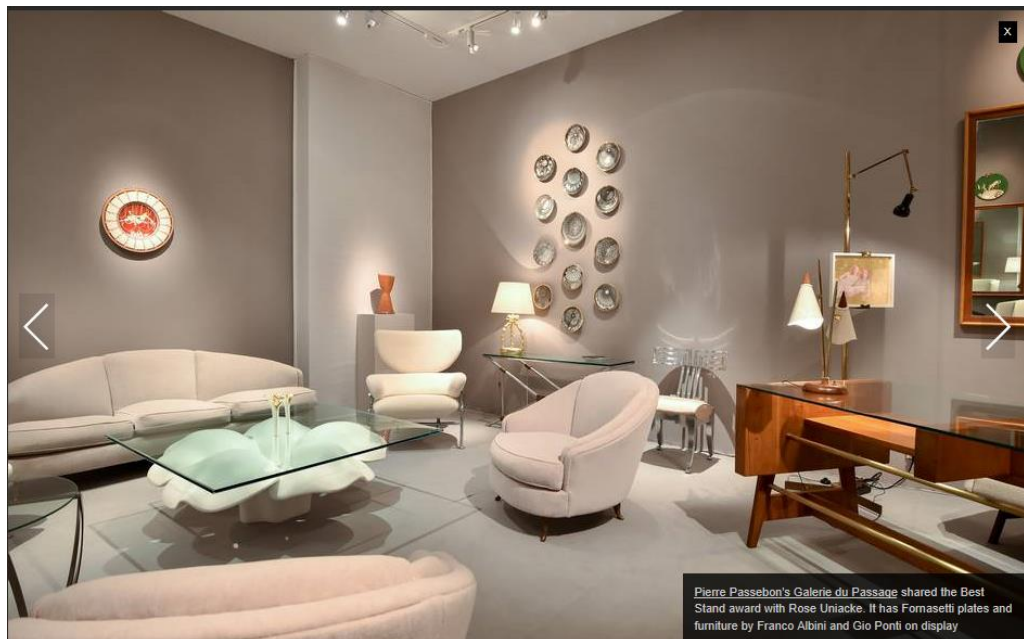

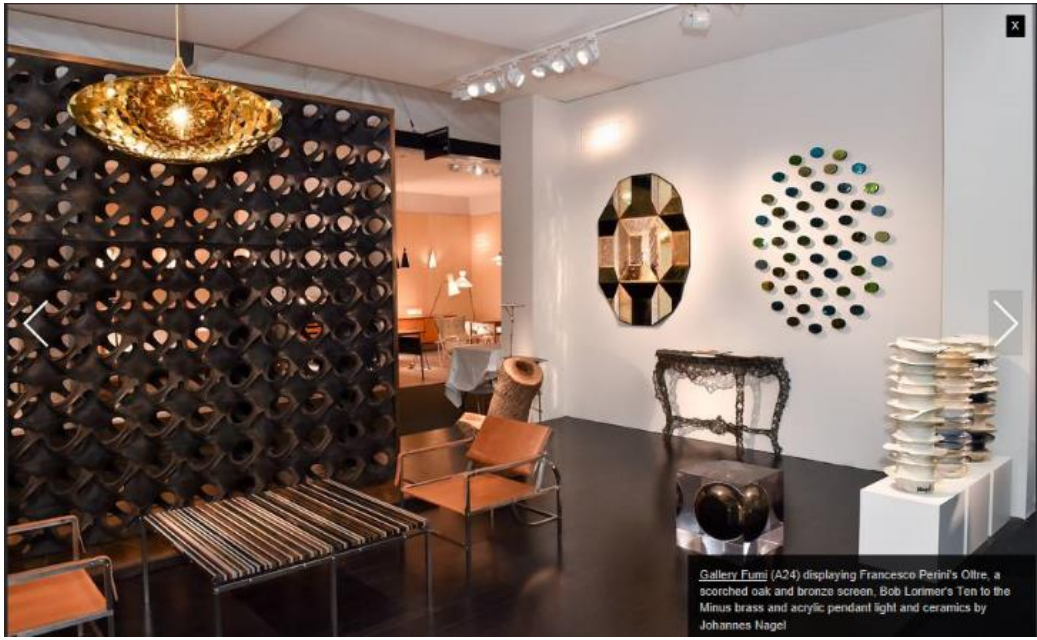
Ammann Gallery (B24) features a range of Nucleo's "Quartz" stone fossil stools
